In Memoriam: William "Ben" Race

During William "Ben" Race's 23-year tenure as a Santa Rosa Junior College Board of Trustee member, Ben made certain the college remained a respected institution of public higher education governed by a non-partisan board committed to the community of which it served.

A well-respected civil engineer, Ben protected the Santa Rosa campus historic educational facilities, committed the college to high architectural and engineering standards and forever preserved its oak-studded vista. He helped to create the Petaluma campus, advised the College to develop its own "stand-alone" Public Safety Training Center in Windsor, and helped to ensure the proper use of the old Forestville WWII radar site that was transformed into Shone Farm agricultural program and forestry education center. Ben continually inspired the SRJC family to make the College one of the very best public community colleges within California and the nation.
