Professor Profile: Brian Antonson, Communication Studies



When you've worked for CNN, CBS, A&E, IFC, MTV, Discovery Channel, Travel Channel and others, teaching college students may not seem like much of a challenge.

But when Brian Antonson and his wife decided to settle down and raise their kids, the challenge and excitement of working with students was nearly on par with his previous experiences. As SRJC's digital filmmaking instructor, he's used his previous experiences filming the aftermath of tragic events like the September 11, 2001 attacks in New York City and Hurricane Katrina in New Orleans and thrilling events like the Giants 2011 Super Bowl win to help teach students the practical skills but also to help them understand what real life in the media/filmmaking industry encompasses, so they can decide if they want a career in the field.

Most importantly for our students, for the last four years, he's transformed the Digital Filmmaking Program at SRJC while teaching our Santa Rosa and Petaluma students about the film and news industry.
