

# SRJC 100<sup>th</sup> ANNIVERSARY CAMPAIGN

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## *Luther Burbank Auditorium: New Spaces and Naming Opportunities*

### **\$500,000 – Theater** (4750 Sq. Ft., plus 1740 Sq. Ft. main stage)

Changes to the theater will be dramatic. The seating pitch will be raised to improve sight lines and enhance both patron and artist experience. The proscenium arch at the front of the stage will be reconfigured, allowing for greater flexibility for adjustments for theatre, dance or music events. A new electronic orchestra pit will be created. The fly tower will be refurbished, including removal and replacement of all rigging elements. Lighting and sound systems will receive a complete overhaul, as will the HVAC system. New seats (including additional disabled seating throughout) will complete the interior space.

### **\$300,000 – Studio (interior)** (2930 Sq. Ft.)

This state-of-the-art performance space with flexible lighting and seating will allow for more intimate and experimental performances and for a significant increase in the quality and quantity of the College's educational offerings. The studio may also be used for additional rehearsal space and as a lecture classroom.

### **\$250,000 – Lobby** (1991 Sq. Ft.)

The expanded and refurbished lobby will include the addition of an elevator, expansion of the Box Office, upgrades for ADA compliance, additional storage space, and a permanent concessions stand. The renovated lobby will be intentionally designed for additional utilization as an event space.

### **\$100,000 – Terrace** (3724 Sq. Ft.)

The new terrace will create a dramatic entrance and will connect the auditorium and new studio space with a large patio ideal for outdoor events and mingling before and after shows.

### **\$100,000 – Gardens** (size to be determined) **(RESERVED)**

The green garden area beyond the new terrace will become a courtyard gathering space for students and patrons alike, and may be used for receptions.

### **\$50,000 – Scene Shop** (4449 Sq. Ft.) **(RESERVED)**

Important upgrades will be made to this expanded space, including the installation of a new dust reclamation system, addition of lighting storage, and addition of technology for teaching lecture classes. New to the space will be a properties craft lab and a recording lab.

***\$50,000 – Costume Lab*** (1663 Sq. Ft.)

The costume laboratory, costume craft area, and laundry room will receive a major expansion and upgrade, and a new OSHA-compliant dye lab for dyeing fabric will be created.

***\$50,000 – Rehearsal Room*** (1599 Sq. Ft.) ***(RESERVED)***

Existing space will be renovated and new space will be added to accommodate both performance rehearsals and performance classes, as well as additional storage for props. Technology and acoustics will be upgraded for teaching lecture classes in the space.

***\$25,000 – Make-up Lab*** (548 Sq. Ft.)

The make-up laboratory will be expanded and upgraded to include new wig storage, new restrooms with showers, and new technology for lecture presentations.

***\$25,000 – Green Room*** (645 Sq. Ft.) ***(RESERVED)***

The new Green Room will be the first in the history of Luther Burbank Auditorium. The creation of a backstage gathering place for students before, during and after performances is essential. The room will include sofas, table and chairs, and kitchen equipment for meal preparation and storage. The Green Room will provide a “home base” for performers, allowing them a designated space to rest and prepare.

***\$25,000 – Office Suite*** (1163 Sq. Ft.)

Dedicated office space will be added to accommodate the work of faculty and staff, allowing for collaboration and providing additional storage.

***\$20,000 – Dressing Room*** (518 Sq. Ft.) ***(RESERVED)***

For the first time in the history of the building, there will be the addition of male and female dressing rooms with curtains.

***\$10,000 – Conference Room*** (352 Sq. Ft.) ***(RESERVED)***

A large, glass conference room complete with kitchenette will adorn the northeast corner of the building and will function as a meeting space for faculty, additional rehearsal space for students, and new space for small reception events.

***\$10,000 – Box Office*** (192 Sq. Ft.) ***(RESERVED)***

The new Box Office will be larger and more visible in its new location at the front of the house, and will provide the benefits of a permanent concessions stand and space for usher training and storage.

***\$1,000 – Theater & Studio Seats***

Contributors who make gifts of \$1,000 or more will be offered the opportunity to name a seat in the renovated Theater or new Studio (limited to seat availability).
